About Indo-UK Oncology Summit 2013

The Indo British Health Initiative (IBHI) and the British Deputy High Commission will jointly organise the biggest ever Indo-UK Oncology Summit in Chennai on 6th & 7th September 2013.

As with diabetes and other non-communicable diseases, the rising incidences of cancer present significant challenges to India. Chennai having a large number of leading institutions with many of the country's best oncology centres situated, we therefore see great value in using an event focused specifically on oncology (with an emphasis on some specific organs) to provide a platform to enable strong and sustainable UK-India partnerships, with the IBHI and the UK Government playing a leading facilitation role.

Background

The Indo British Health Initiative aims to promote scientific collaboration between healthcare personnel in the United Kingdom and India. It also seeks to facilitate more UK higher education partnerships and business opportunities for UK commercial firms in the healthcare sector in India. The IBHI foundation was mainly formed to facilitate and channelize these initiatives.
