ABOUT INDO - UK HIPEC MEET 2014

The Indo-British Health Initiative (IBHI) is organising the Indo-UK HIPEC Meet, the most latest and advanced technique in the speciality in Chennai on 21st & 22nd November, 2014.

Hyperthermic Intraperitoneal Chemotherapy (HIPEC) is a highly concentrated, heated chemotherapy treatment that is delivered directly to the abdomen during surgery. The procedure also improves drug absorption and effect with minimal exposure to the rest of the body. In this way, the normal side effects of chemotherapy can be avoided. HIPEC is a treatment option for people who have advanced surface spread of cancer within the abdomen, without disease involvement outside of the abdomen.

BACKGROUND

The Indo British Health Initiative aims to promote scientific collaboration between Health Care Personnel in the United Kingdom and India. It also seeks to facilitate more UK higher education partnerships and business opportunities for UK commercial firms in the healthcare sector in India.

The IBHI foundation was mainly formed to facilitate and channelize these initiatives.

IBHI was established in December, 2011 by **Dr. Prithvi Mohandas** (Founder and Secretary – IBHI)
